1. These bail applications under Section 483 of BNSS are filed by the applicants-accused **Ravi Urf Ravindra Urf Rinku S/o Sohanlal and Basant Kumar Parsoya S/o Banna**

Ram, seeking bail in respect of a criminal case registered as FIR No.76/2026 dated 19.03.2026 registered at P.S. CPS District - ACB Jaipur, for the offence under Sections 7, 7A of PC Act and 61(2) of BNS.

2. Learned counsels for the applicants submits that the applicants have been falsely implicated in the matter and the investigation against them is complete and they are no more required in investigation. They further submits that there are no chance of fleeing of applicant accused from the jurisdiction of this Hon'ble Court. They also submits that the applicants undertakes not to repeat offence and cooperate with trial, which will take time.
3. Learned counsel for petitioner Ravi @ Ravindra, submitted that the petitioner is a private employee and he is working on a monthly salary of ₹9,000/-. He further submitted that the petitioner is neither a government employee nor a middleman, a beneficiary in any manner. He further submitted that the investigation is completed and ACB is about to file the charge sheet, which is evident from the report submitted by the ACB.
4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of Basant Kumar submitted that the petitioner is working as a Tehsildar and he has not demanded any amount of bribe from the complainant. He further referred Annexure-4 and submitted that the work was not pending with the present petitioner, rather the work was with the Patwari. He further submitted that the document clearly indicates that neither was there any proper verification nor was any demand for bribe and

moreover no work was pending. He further referred the transcription and submitted that in a haphazard manner this transcription has been prepared by the ACB, which is sufficient to draw a conclusion that the ACB has laid the trap only to implicate the present petitioner. At last, he submitted that there is no criminal antecedent against the petitioner and the petitioner is in custody for approximately two months.

5. Learned Public Prosecutor has vehemently opposed the bail applications and submitted that the allegations are grave and serious in nature. He has also filed a report received from concerned Police Station.
6. Heard learned counsel for the parties and learned Public Prosecutor. Perused the material placed on record by both the parties.
7. On 13.03.2026, complainant Rajkumar lodged a complaint regarding difficulty in mutation and when he met Ravi @ Ravindra, then Ravi told him that the Tehsildar is demanding bribe from for mutation. The complainant reported that he does not want to pay any bribe. On the basis of the complaint, a verification was conducted and a trap was planned. ₹1,50,000/- was paid to Ravi @ Ravindra on behalf of Basant Kumar. After registration of FIR No. 76/2026 dated 19.03.2026, the matter was investigated. Ravi @ Ravindr was arrested on 17.03.2026 and Basant Kumar was also arrested on 17.03.2026. Currently, both the petitioners are in judicial custody.

8. The report submitted by the ACB indicates that the investigation is concluded and it is in the process of filing the charge sheet. Both the petitioners are in custody since their arrest on 17.03.2026 and recovery is from Ravi @ Ravindra, who is a private employee, though he has demanded bribe on behalf of Basant Kumar. Considering the overall circumstances and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, it is appropriate to allow the bail application of both the petitioners.
9. Upon hearing the arguments and perusing the record, we have found that the applicants-accused are no more required in the investigation and they are in custody for quite some time. The further proceedings will take its own time, therefore, looking to entirety of facts and circumstances of the case and without expressing any opinion on merits of the case, the Court deems it appropriate to grant bail to the applicants-accused.
10. Thus, the instant bail applications filed on behalf of applicants-accused **Ravi Urf Ravindra Urf Rinku S/o Sohanlal and Basant Kumar Parsoya S/o Banna Ram**, are hereby allowed and the applicants-accused are ordered to be released on bail with condition that each of the petitioner would furnish a personal bond of ₹50,000/- with two sureties of like amount to the satisfaction of the Trial Court with the following conditions:-
 - (i) The applicants-accused shall not tamper with evidence or influence the witness in any manner.

- (ii) The applicants-accused shall not indulge in any criminal activity and shall not repeat any criminal offence punishable under the Law.
- (iii) The applicants-accused shall attend the hearing of the Trial Court on the date fixed by the Trial court or as and when asked to appear before the Trial Court.
- (iv) In case of any violation of above conditions, the bail granted to the applicants-accused shall be liable to be canceled.

11. The Registry is directed to send a copy of this order to the Trial Court through E-mail.
