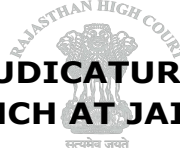

1. The present writ petition has been filed by the petitioner seeking a direction to the learned Trial Court to expeditiously dispose of Civil Suit No. 137/2024 within a period of two months.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner filed a civil suit bearing No. 137/2024 in the year 2024, wherein the defendants chose not to appear before the learned Trial Court and consequently, *ex-parte* proceedings were drawn against them on 07.10.2024.
3. He further submits that on 10.03.2025, the *ex-parte* evidence of the plaintiff was concluded with the statement of Rahul Dave (PW-1), and the matter was fixed for final arguments on 21.04.2025. However, for the last one year, the learned Trial Court has not been hearing the final *ex-parte* arguments and has been granting adjournments on every date. Therefore, he prays that the learned Trial Court may kindly be directed to dispose of



the suit in an expeditious manner, preferably within a period of two months.

4. Heard and considered the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner and perused the material available on record.

5. In view of the peculiar facts of the case, more particularly: (i) *ex-parte* proceedings were drawn up against the defendants on 07.10.2024; (ii) as per the order sheet dated 10.03.2025, the *ex-parte* evidence of the plaintiff was concluded with the statement of Rahul Dave (PW-1); (iii) the matter was fixed for final *ex-parte* arguments on 21.04.2025, and has been pending ever since despite the passage of one year; and (iv) the *ex-parte* proceedings against the defendants have also not been contested ever since they were drawn up on 07.10.2024. Therefore, the learned Trial Court is directed to decide the pending Civil Suit bearing No. 137/2024, preferably within a period of three (3) months from the next date fixed in the matter, strictly in accordance with law.

6. With the aforesaid direction, the present civil writ petition is disposed of.

7. All pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
