1. The present bail application has been filed under Section 483 of BNSS, 2023 against the order dated 17.02.2026 passed by the learned Sessions Judge, District-Karauli, in Criminal Misc. Case No. 71/2026, whereby the bail application of the petitioner was rejected in connection with F.I.R. No.186/2025, Police Station Kotwali, District-Karauli for the offences under Sections 318(4), 316(2) of the BNS, 2023.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been in custody pursuant to a production warrant since 31.01.2026, having already been arrested and lodged in judicial custody in District Ambala, Haryana. It is further submitted that

the total amount allegedly involved in the present case is approximately Rs. 89,999/-.

3. Learned counsel further submits that only one other criminal case is pending against the petitioner, namely FIR No. 59/2025, in connection with which he was in custody and from where he was produced on a production warrant in the present case.

4. It is further contended that the challan has already been filed and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take a considerable period of time. It is also submitted that the offences alleged are triable by the learned Magistrate. Therefore, it is prayed that the petitioner, who has been in custody since 31.01.2026, may be enlarged on bail.

5. Learned Public Prosecutor vehemently opposes the bail applications.

6. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Public Prosecutor and perused the material available on record.

7. Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case and upon consideration of the arguments advanced that the challan in the case has already been filed and the conclusion of trial will take sufficiently long time and even the offences are triable by the Magistrate, this Court deems it appropriate to enlarge the petitioner on bail subject to the condition that petitioner is not required in any other FIR.

8. Consequently, the bail application is **allowed**. It is ordered that the accused-petitioner namely **Sarabjit Singh S/o Hardayal Singh** arrested in connection with F.I.R. No.186/2025, Police Station Kotwali, District-Karauli, shall be released on bail; provided he furnish a personal bond of Rs.1,00,000/- (Rs. One

Lakh Only) with two sureties of Rs. 50,000/- (Rs. Fifty Thousand Only) each, to the satisfaction of the learned Trial Court, with the stipulation that he shall appear before the said Court on all dates of hearing and as and when called upon to do so until completion of the trial, subject to the following conditions:

- (i) The petitioner shall not leave country without the permission of the Court;*
- (ii) The petitioner shall not commit any offence similar to the offence of which they are accused, or suspected, of the commission of which they are suspected;*
- (iii) The petitioner shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer or tamper with the evidence; and*
- (iv) In the event the petitioner is found involved in any other cyber fraud case in the future, the prosecution shall be at liberty to move an appropriate application before the learned trial Court for cancellation of the bail granted herein.*
