It is submitted that the petitioner who has entered into a consortium in-between petitioner Nos.1 and 2 has applied as a bidder with a tender flouted by BSNL. It is submitted that the quantum of which is Rs.180 Crores, and his rejection by way of Annexure-11 is on account of non-speaking and vague reason which is spelled out as under:

"Due to non fulfillment of eligibility conditions."

Learned counsel has submitted that by way of Annexure-10 i.e. email dated 30.03.2026, whereby, it was informed that the petitioner's bid was perhaps rejected on account of being a partnership firm, not fulfilling the eligibility conditions and further as it did not possess the work experience certificate, and the same was a mandatory eligibility. Howsoever, it was also explained that the consortium to the petitioner No.2 was fulfilling the basic requirements.

It is submitted that the tender process is ongoing and work order can be issued at any time, soon. It is submitted that his

financial bid is of the successful bidder as that of Rs. 186 Crores against Rs. 191 Crores.
