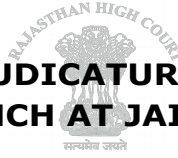

1. It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioners that petitioners have falsely been implicated under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of IPC. The complainant has registered the FIR alleging the fact that the petitioner along with other co-accused Hemant Sharma by cheating the complainant executed a sale deed.
2. It is contended that the petitioner was not aware about the fact that the some dispute was pending between Mahendra Kumar and Hemant Dutt. The petitioners are bonafide purchasers, therefore petitioners may be protected.



3. Learned Public Prosecutor seeks time to procure the factual report so also to file the reply.
4. Heard and perused the material available on record.
5. It is not desirable to express anything on the merits of the case, considering the arguments raised by counsel for the petitioners, I deem it proper to protect the petitioners till further orders and direct the concerned SHO, Investigating Officer to not to take any coercive action against the present petitioners pertaining to FIR No.505/2023, registered at Police Station Kaman, District Deeg for the offences under Section 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of IPC. The petitioners shall also cooperate with the investigation.
6. Issue notice to the respondent No.2 subject to condition that the petitioners shall file the requisites within a period of a week.
7. List the matter after three weeks, till then, no coercive action shall be taken against the petitioners.
