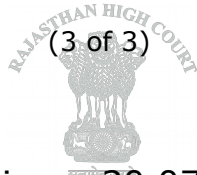

1. The Officers have connected through video conferencing and the Additional Chief Secretary, Water Resources Department and Irrigation informs about a project having been launched for bringing water to the Ramgarh Dam from Isarda is around 105 Km.
2. It is informed to the Court that the project is likely to reach its completion by April, 2028.
3. Dr. Abhinav Sharma, Amicus Curiae has pointed out that some references which were made to the Board of Revenue have been decided.
4. Let all the documents relating to the same be filed before this Court.
5. Learned Advocate General shall submit a comprehensive affidavit after due consultation from all the concerned officers to propose ways and means of flow of water through natural resources and also suggest how to remove the encroachments or any anicut and any other difficulties which may have arise in hindrance to the flow of water.
6. Further presence of the Additional Chief Secretary and his officers are exempted for future. However, we would request the District Collector to remain present at the time of hearing through video conferencing so that adequate inputs may be received from him also at that relevant time.
7. The Amicus Curiae will be provided all the necessary documents to assist the Court.
