The present 2nd application has been filed on behalf of the applicant/ appellant, namely Yogendra @ Kalla under Section 430 of the *Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023* seeking interim bail/suspension of sentence on the ground of the marriages of his two cousin brothers, namely Krishan & Hariom, which are scheduled to be solemnized on 25.04.2026.

Submissions of learned counsel on behalf of the applicant-appellant are that the marriages of the applicant's two cousin brothers, namely Krishan & Hariom are to be solemnized on 25.04.2026. As per the marriage card (Annexure-A/1), the wedding ceremonies will commence from 23.04.2026 onwards. The presence of the applicant, being the brother of the grooms, is required to perform essential customary, religious and social obligations. Therefore, it is prayed that the applicant be granted interim bail/suspension of sentence.

In compliance of the order dt.17.04.2026 passed by this Court, learned Public Prosecutor for the State, while submitting the verification report, has verified the factum of the marriages of the applicant's two cousin brothers. The aforesaid report is taken on record.

Heard. Perused the material made available on record.

Taking into consideration the submission made by learned counsel appearing for applicant-appellant and the fact that the aforesaid marriages are going to be solemnized on 25.04.2026, but without expressing any opinion on the merits/demerits of the case, in the interest of justice, this Court deems it just and proper to enlarge the applicant on interim bail/ suspension of sentence, at this stage.

Accordingly, the 2nd interim suspension of sentence application is **allowed** and it is, hereby, directed that the Superintendent/ concerned authority, Central Jail, Alwar, shall release the applicant, namely Kamal Kumar on interim bail, which shall commence from the date of his actual release forthwith, upon furnishing his personal bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with two sureties of Rs.25,000/- each to the satisfaction of the Superintendent/concerned authority, Central Jail, Alwar, with the stipulation that he shall surrender himself before the Superintendent/concerned authority, Central Jail, Alwar, after completion a period of **seven-days at 05:00 P.M.** from the date of his release. He shall also maintain peace and tranquility during the period of interim bail. In case, he fails to surrender on the stipulated date, the jail authority shall proceed in accordance with law.
