1. The appeal lies under Section 57 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 against the order of seizure. However, instead of filing an appeal, directly this writ petition has been filed before the Court. In regard to seizure of vehicle, there are always disputed question of facts which need to be examined and the Appellate Forum would be the best to consider the entire record and pass an order on factual aspects.
2. The writ petition though is maintainable would not be a correct option as this Court under Article 226 of the Constitution has limited scope for examining the facts.

3. In view thereto, we dismiss the writ petition with liberty to file an appeal.

4. If an appeal is preferred before the Appellate Authority within a period of fifteen (15) days from today, it is expected from the Appellate Authority to consider the same within one month thereafter.

5. All pending misc. applications stand disposed of.
