1. Mr. Brahma Prakash is appearing on caveat.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the application under Order 1 Rule 10 CPC has been allowed by the learned trial Court, thereby impleading respondent No. 4 in the suit, which was filed by the plaintiff-petitioner.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that he had not sought any relief against respondent No. 4; his relief was solely sought against respondent Nos. 1, 2, and 3. He also contends that no relief has been claimed against respondent No. 4, and the relief in the suit is confined to respondent Nos. 1, 2, and 3.
4. Additionally, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the suit was filed seeking a declaration based on adverse possession. He submits that respondent No. 4, who has been added as a party through the application, does not claim to be the owner of the property in dispute. He further contends that respondent No. 4 was neither a necessary nor a proper party to the suit.

5. Heard.

6. Let notice be issue to the respondent No.1, 2 and 3. Rule is made returnable within two weeks'.

7. In the meanwhile, the learned trial Court is restrained from passing any final judgment in the Case No. 34/61/2019 pending before the Court of learned Senior Civil Judge-cum-Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, No. 2, Behror, District Kotputli-Behror.

8. List this matter after two weeks.
