1. By way of filing the instant criminal misc. petition, a prayer has been made for issuing directions to the respondents No.2 and 3 for providing protection to the petitioners as they are under threat from respondents No.4 and 5.

2. This Court vide order dated 16.04.2019, passed an interim order directing the respondent No.3 to ensure that no physical harm is caused to the petitioners. More than six years have passed thereafter and the threat perception might be over at this point. Hence, under these circumstances, this Court does not find it justified to continue with the instant petition.

3. Accordingly, the instant criminal misc. petition stands disposed of, granting liberty to the petitioners to file appropriate representation before the respondent No.3, in case they are still under the apprehension of any threat to their life and personal liberty. In case such an application is submitted by the petitioners, the respondent No.3 shall consider the same and pass appropriate orders, strictly in accordance with law.

4. Pending application, if any, also stand disposed of.
