1. The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though there are four children of deceased Government Servant (late Smt. Shanti Bai), however, the petitioner was living with her and dependent on her salary.

2. Admittedly, three children of the deceased Government Servant are Government Servants. As per Rule 5 of the Rajasthan Compassionate Appointment of Dependents of Deceased Government Servants Rules, 1996, (hereinafter is to be referred to as 'the Rules of 1996') the appointment is not admissible in cases where the spouse or at least one of the sons, unmarried daughters, adopted son/adopted unmarried daughter of the deceased Government Servant is already employed on regular

basis under the Central/ any State Government or Statutory Board, Organisation/ Corporation.

3. Admittedly, three of the dependents of the deceased are employed with the State of Rajasthan.

4. In view of the provisions of Rule 5 of the Rules of 1996, the claim of the petitioner for appointment on compassionate ground is not acceptable.

5. Accordingly, this writ petition is dismissed being devoid of merits.
