Mr. Anjani Kumar Sharma, learned counsel enters appearance and takes notice on behalf of respondent No.1.

Mr. Sandeep Pathak, learned counsel enters appearance and takes notice on behalf of respondents No.2 to 4.

Mr. Sandeep Taneja, learned Additional Advocate General enters appearance and takes notice on behalf of respondents No.5 and 6.

Learned counsel for the respondents are granted four weeks' time to file reply.

Rejoinder be filed within two weeks thereafter.

List this matter after six weeks along with D.B. Civil Writ Petitions No.9794/2024, 5484/2025, 1367/2025, 3006/2025 and other connected matters.

In the meanwhile, taking into consideration the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner that the impugned adjudication order suffers from serious violation of principles of natural justice inasmuch as the statements of large number of witnesses have been taken into consideration to record adverse findings who were not allowed to be cross-examined despite repeated requests made by petitioner, no coercive action for recovery shall be taken on the basis of the impugned order.

Respondents are granted liberty to file application for vacation of stay order.
