- 1. This anticipatory bail application has been filed under Section 482 of BNSS, 2023 on behalf of accused-petitioners in connection with FIR No.192/2025 registered at Police Station Kishanganj, District Baran for the offences under Sections 109(1), 62 and 3(5) of BNS, 2023.
- 2. Learned counsel for the accused-petitioners submits that the accused-petitioners have been implicated in this case based on false and fabricated facts. She further submits that in the FIR, the allegations are against one Nikhil Goswami and Vishal Pankaj and there is no reference of any third person. She also submits that the accused-petitioners are ready to cooperate with the investigation.

3. Learned Public Prosecutor vehemently opposed the bail application and submits that as per the investigation report, the accused-petitioners were found involved in making conspiracy alongwith co-accused, namely, Nikhil Goswami and Vishal Pankaj.
4. Considered the submissions made by counsel for the accused-petitioners as well as learned Public Prosecutor and also perused the case diary.
5. As per the contents of the FIR, it has been revealed that when the complainant was going to his house, two persons on motorcycle which was driven by Nikhil Goswami and Vishal Pankaj who was pillion rider inflicted injury on the head of the complainant by wooden stick. In the FIR, neither the accused-petitioners were named showing their presence on the spot nor there was any allegation against them.
6. Taking into consideration the material facts that there is no allegation against the accused-petitioners in the FIR, this Court without expressing any opinion on the merits or demerits of the case deems just and proper to extend the benefit of anticipatory bail to the accused-petitioners.
7. Accordingly, this anticipatory bail application under Section 482 B.N.S.S. is allowed and it is ordered that in the event of arrest of the accused-petitioners named above in connection with FIR No.192/2025 registered at Police Station Kishanganj, District Baran shall be released on bail, provided each of them furnish a personal bond in the sum of Rs.1,00,000/- together with two sureties in the sum of Rs.50,000/- each to the satisfaction of the S.H.O/I.O/Arresting Officer of the concerned Police Station on the

following conditions:-

- (i) that the petitioners shall make themselves available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;
- (ii) that the petitioners shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the court or any police officer, and
- (iii) that the petitioners shall not leave India without previous permission of the court.
