1. Petitioner has filed this writ petition assailing order dated 17.02.2025 issued by the Tehsildar Mahuwa, District Dausa whereby, the claim for traveling allowance raised by the petitioner has been rejected. It is stated that after attaining the age of superannuation, the petitioner retired from service w.e.f.

31.08.2020 and before his retirement, the petitioner submitted bills for traveling allowance amount to Rs.3714/- and 3081/-, however, the same was not paid and in quite arbitrary manner and ignorance of the rules, the claim has been rejected vide order dated 19.02.2025.

2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and perused the record.

3. Bare perusal of order dated 19.02.2025 would reveal that the bill submitted by the petitioner have been examined by the Competent Authority in accordance with available record and it was found that there was no order permitting the petitioner to undertake traveling and even no document after due verification for the Competent Authority was produced by the petitioner in support of his bills for sanction of traveling allowance. Under these circumstances and in view of the factual statement given in order dated 19.02.2025, this Court does not find any ground to interfere in this writ petition and the same is hereby, dismissed.

4. Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
