1. For the reasons mentioned in the application (1/2026), the
same is allowed.

2. With consent of learned counsel for both the parties, the matter is heard on the stay application today itself.
3. Learned counsel for the appellants submits that the appellants are ready and willing to deposit the entire decreetal amount along with the interest within a period of two weeks from today and prays to stay the execution of the decree.
4. Learned counsel for the respondent has no objection to the submission made by learned counsel for the appellants.
5. In view of above, further execution of decree dated 08.02.2024 and amended decree dated 22.03.2024 passed by the Additional District Judge No.2, Bandikui, District Dausa, in Civil Suit No.12/2018 shall remain stayed subject to the appellants depositing the entire decreetal amount along with the interest accrued thereon before the concerned Court within a period of two weeks from today.
6. On such deposit being made, the amount shall be kept in FDR with a Nationalized Bank initially for a period of one year, which shall be renewed from time to time.
7. Accordingly, the stay application is disposed of.
