The present writ petition has been preferred by the petitioner assailing the order dated 09.03.2026 passed by the learned Additional District & Sessions Judge No.8, Jaipur Metropolitan-I, Jaipur (Rajasthan) in Civil Suit No. 35/2019, titled as '*Ranjeet Singh Vs. Sarvadaman Singh*', whereby the petitioner's application filed under Order 1 Rule 10 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 (CPC), was rejected.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the learned Court below seriously erred in rejecting the application filed under Order 1 Rule 10 of CPC, without appreciating the fact that the petitioner's probate application in relation to a Will dated 04.08.1994, which pertains to be a part of the suit land, has already been decided in her favour vide judgment dated 17.02.2018 passed by the learned Additional District Judge No.10, Jaipur Metropolitan-I, Jaipur, and it reflects that the petitioner has a share in the suit property, yet she has not been impleaded as a

party to the suit. He therefore prays that the impugned order dated 09.03.2026 being perverse, may kindly be quashed and set aside.

3. Heard.

4. In view of the submissions made hereinabove, issue notice to the respondents, returnable within six weeks.

5. Requisite PF and notices may be filed within a period of one week. Upon filing the same, one set be sent by ordinary post and another by registered post.

6. List the matter after six weeks.
