1. These instant bail applications have been filed under Section 483 BNSS on behalf of accused-petitioners. The petitioners have been arrested in connection with FIR No.752/2024 registered at Police Station Kumher, District Deeg for the offence(s) under Sections 115(2), 126(2), 190, 191(2), 303(2) and 109(1) of BNS and Section 3/25(6) of Arms Act.

2. Learned counsel for the accused-petitioners submits that the accused-petitioners have falsely been implicated in this case. He further submits that the allegation of causing fire arm injury is not attributed to the present petitioners, no fire arm was recovered at the instance of present petitioners. The names of the petitioners are not mentioned in the FIR. The other similarly placed co-accused namely: Naresh Kumar S/o Pokhan Singh, Chandraveer Singh @ Anna and Nishul @ Nishu have already been enlarged on bail by this Court. The accused-petitioners are in custody since long and charge-sheet against the accused-petitioners have already been submitted before the concerned Court and further trial of the case may take considerable time, therefore, the bail applications of the accused-petitioners may be allowed.

3. Learned Public Prosecutor has vehemently opposed the bail applications and contended that the accused-petitioners along

with the other co-accused caused fire arm injury to the injured Devraj Singh, this fact is specifically mentioned in the statement of PW-1 Girish and PW-2 Devraj, therefore, considering the nature of offence, these bail applications of the accused-petitioners may be dismissed.

4. Heard and perused the material available on record.

5. Considering the fact that injured PW-2 Devraj, in his Court statement has attributed the fire arm injury to other co-accused Devendra @ Deva and Sachin. No fire arm was recovered at the instance of the present petitioners. The other similarly placed co-accused namely: Naresh Kumar S/o Pokhan Singh, Chandraveer Singh @ Anna and Nishul @ Nishu have already been enlarged on bail. The accused-petitioners are in custody since long and trial of the case may take considerable time, therefore, considering the above facts, I deem it just and proper to enlarge the accused-petitioners on bail.

6. Accordingly, the bail applications under Section 483 BNSS are allowed and it is ordered that the accused-petitioners namely:

1. Vishvendra Singh S/o Shri Mohan Singh, 2. Danveer Singh @ Kalua S/o Naharsingh, 3. Gambhir @ Gautam S/o Shri Jotram, R/o Surota and 4. Balram S/o Dalveer, in connection with FIR No.752/2024 registered at Police Station Kumher, District Deeg shall be enlarged on bail provided each of them furnish a personal bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with two sureties of Rs.25,000/- each to the satisfaction of the learned trial Judge for their appearance before the court concerned on all the dates of hearing and as and when called upon to do so.

7. The accused-petitioner Balram S/o Dalveer, is also directed to mark his presence on 25th of every month till conclusion of trial before the concerned police station. The SHO of the concerned police station is directed to maintain a regular register marking the presence of the accused-petitioner and shall send the presence report of the accused-petitioner on the same day to the concerned Trial Court without any delay.
