1. The instant bail application has been filed on behalf of the accused-petitioners under Section 483 of BNSS in connection with FIR No. 81/2026 registered at Police Station Dudu, District Jaipur Rural for the offence(s) punishable under Sections 19, 54 & 54(A) of the Rajasthan Excise Act, 1950.
2. Learned counsel for the accused-petitioners submits that the accused-petitioners have been falsely implicated in this case. He also submits that there are no criminal cases pending against them and recovery has already been effected. He further submits that the accused-petitioners are in custody since 01.04.2026; conclusion of trial will take its own time, so no fruitful purpose would be served by keeping the accused-petitioners behind the bars and, therefore, prays that the accused-petitioners may be granted the benefit of bail under Section 483 of BNSS.

3. *Per contra*, learned Public Prosecutor vehemently opposes the submissions made by learned counsel for the accused-petitioners hereinabove.

4. Having regard to the totality of the facts and circumstances of the case and considering the fact that there are no criminal cases pending against him and recovery has already been effected. The accused-petitioners are in custody since 01.04.2026; that trial will take its own time. Hence, this Court without expressing any opinion on the merits/demerits of the case, deems it just and proper to enlarge the accused-petitioners on bail.

5. Therefore, the instant bail application under Section 483 BNSS is accordingly, **allowed** and the accused-petitioners **Magan Choudhary S/o Shri Choturam & Jeetaram Choudhary S/o Ridhakaran Choudhary** are ordered to be released on bail, provided each of them furnishes a personal bond in the sum of Rs. 1,00,000/- with two sureties of Rs. 50,000/- each to the satisfaction of the Trial Court, with the stipulation that he shall appear before that Court and any Court to which the matter is transferred, on all subsequent dates of hearing and as and when called upon to do so.

6. The observation made hereinabove is only for decision of the instant bail application and would not have any impact on the trial of the case in any manner.
