1. The instant bail application has been filed under Section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 on behalf of accused-petitioner in connection with FIR No. 03/2026 registered at Police Station Jawar, District Jhalawar for offence under Sections 8, 21, 30 of the N.D.P.S. Act 1985 against the order dated 09.04.2026 whereby learned Trial Court dismissed the bail application filed by the accused-petitioner for the offences punishable under Section 8/21, 29 of the NDPS Act.
2. Heard.
3. Considered the submissions made by the counsel for the petitioner as well as learned Public Prosecutor.
4. The allegation against the accused-petitioner is that he provided the alleged contraband i.e. 70 gram *smack* to the co-accused 'Pappulal' from whose possession it was recovered. The accused-petitioner is in custody since 05.04.2026 and co-accused



from whose possession contraband has been recovered has already been enlarged on bail.

5. The accused-petitioner has been made an accused on the basis of the statements of the co-accused with the aid of Section 8/29 of the N.D.P.S. Act.

6. Taking into consideration the overall facts and circumstances of the case, this Court without expressing any opinion on the merits and demerits of the case, deems just and proper to enlarge the accused-petitioner on bail.

7. Accordingly, the present bail application is allowed and it is directed that the accused-petitioner shall be released on bail provided that he furnishes a personal bond in the sum of Rs.1,00,000/- (Rupees One Lax Only) together with two sureties in the sum of Rs.50,000/-(Rupees Fifty Thousand Only) each to the satisfaction of the learned Trial Court with the stipulation that he shall appear before that Court or any Court to which the matter is transferred, on all subsequent dates of hearing and as and when called upon to do so.

8. However, it is made clear that in case the accused-petitioner is found to be involved in any other criminal case of similar nature in future, the prosecution would be at liberty to move an application for cancellation of this bail order.
