1. While impugning the award dated 11.02.2026 passed by learned Additional District and Session Judge No.1, Kishangarh, Ajmer (Raj.), whereby the petitioner-Insurance Company was directed to pay the amount of Rs. 56,34,631/-, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner-Insurance Company was directed to pay certain amount vide order dated 29.08.2022 passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court and in furtherance thereof, the petitioner had deposited substantial amount. However, certain amount is still required to be deposited by the petitioner. He further submits that the petitioner is ready to deposit the due amount as directed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court but there appears to be some calculation error in the impugned order passed by the learned Tribunal. He therefor prays that the amount may be recalculated and the impugned order may be modified to that extent.

2. Heard.

3. Mr. Sandeep Mathur appears on behalf of Respondent No.1. Thus, service stands complete.
4. Notices need not be issued to the remaining respondents as they are proforma respondents.
5. In the meanwhile, the effect and operation of the impugned award dated 11.02.2026 passed by learned Additional District and Session Judge No.1, Kishangarh, Ajmer (Raj.), in Case No.06/2022 (CIS No.11/2022) titled as '*Shashikant Bagrecha v. Shahajahna & Ors.*' shall remain stayed, provided the petitioner deposits the entire awarded amount i.e. Rs.56,34,631/- along with 6% interest to the claimants/respondents with the learned Additional District and Session Judge No.1, Kishangarh, Ajmer (Raj.), within a period of four weeks from today.
6. On depositing the entire awarded amount i.e. Rs.56,34,631/- along with 6% interest per annum; 50% of the awarded amount may be disbursed to the claimants/respondents on filing an undertaking on oath to the effect that, in case the present writ petition is allowed the respondents will return the said sum to the petitioners along with interest @ 6% p.a.; and the remaining 50% of the awarded amount shall be invested in FDR in any nationalized bank and the same shall not be disbursed to the respondents without leave of this Court.
7. List the matter after eight weeks.
