Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that a disciplinary proceeding was initiated against the petitioner and memorandum of charge was issued to him. Counsel submits that reply to the charge-sheet has already been submitted by the petitioner. Counsel submits that according to the Circular No. F.16633/F. 19(27) Apptts. (A)/60 dated 17.03.1960, issued by the Department of Personnel, departmental enquiry should be completed within a period of three months from the date of appointment of Enquiry Officer. Thus, learned counsel for petitioner seeks permission to withdraw this writ petition with liberty to raise all available ground in this petition before the

Enquiry Officer during the course of enquiry. Simultaneously, he prays that Enquiry Officer may be directed to complete the enquiry within time bound period and strictly in accordance with the aforesaid circular issued in this regard.

Permission sought for is granted.

Accordingly, this Civil Writ Petition stands dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.

However, the Enquiry Officer shall make all endeavour to complete the enquiry against the petitioner as per the aforesaid Circular dated 17.03.1960, issued by the Department of Personnel.
