1. The instant appeal has been filed under Section 14A of SC/ST (Prevention Of Atrocities) Act on behalf of the appellant, who is in custody in connection with FIR No. 89/2025 Police Station Asnawar, District Jhalawar for the offences under Sections 140(3), 308(5), 189(2), 189(3), 127(2), 115(2) of BNS 2023 and Sections 3(1)(r), 3(1)(s) of the SC/ST (Prevention Of Atrocities) Act.

2. It is submitted by learned counsel for the appellant that first criminal appeal was dismissed as withdrawn. It is submitted that co-accused Pravat has been granted the benefit of bail. It is submitted that the case of the appellant is on same pedestal and

hence parity is ought to be maintained; and that charge-sheet has been filed.

3. *Per contra*, learned Public Prosecutor has vehemently opposed the instant criminal appeal. In spite of service, none has marked attendance *qua* the complainant.

4. Having heard the arguments advanced by learned counsel for the parties, considering that co-accused Pravat has been granted the benefit of bail; that the case of the appellant is on same pedestal and hence parity is ought to be maintained; that charge-sheet has already been filed, and looking to the overall facts and circumstances of the case and material on record but without commenting on merits/demerits of the case, this court is inclined to enlarge the accused-appellant on bail.

5. Consequently, the instant appeal is **allowed**. The impugned order dated 06.04.2026 passed by the Special Judge, SC/ST (Prevention Of Atrocities) Cases, Jhalawar is set aside. It is ordered that the accused-appellant **Anurag Singh Alias Monu Banna S/o Bhanwar Singh** arrested in connection with aforesaid FIR, shall be released on bail, if not wanted in any other case, provided he furnishes a personal bond of Rs.50,000/- and two sureties of Rs.25,000/- each to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court with the stipulation to appear before that Court on all dates of hearing and as and when called upon to do so.
