1. This misc. second bail application has been filed by the petitioner Raghuvir Singh S/o Shri Dharmchand, in connection with the FIR bearing No.670/2016 registered at Police Station Bajaj Nagar, District Jaipur East dated 08.11.2016 for the offences punishable under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120B of IPC.
2. The first bail application of the petitioner was dismissed as withdrawn by this Court vide order dated 17.12.2025 with liberty to file afresh on change of circumstances.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case and he has undergone substantial period of incarceration. Learned counsel further submits that the FIR has been registered after an inordinate delay

and the petitioner has been enlarged on bail in other similar cases by the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court and no further recovery is required to be made from him. In view of these change in circumstances, learned counsel prays that the petitioner may be enlarged on bail.

4. Learned Public Prosecutor as well as learned counsel for the complainant vehemently opposed the bail application.

5. Heard learned counsel for the parties.

6. This Court, after perusal of the conclusion as recorded in the charge-sheet filed under Section 299 Cr.P.C., noted that the Investigating Officer has recorded the serious involvement of the petitioner herein. Further, the FIR was registered way back in the year 2016 and the charge-sheet under Section 299 Cr.P.C. dated 04.07.2018 and the he continued to abscond the proceedings from 2016/2018 till he was produced on production warrant and, thereafter, was sent to judicial custody on 09.10.2025. A person like the petitioner herein, who avoided the investigation and, further, even after filing of the charge-sheet is now presenting himself to be an innocent person, which is not the case herein and such person cannot be granted the indulgence by this Court while exercising its power under Section 483 B.N.S.S..

7. Consequently, this misc. second bail application is dismissed in view of the above noted serious conduct of the petitioner and conclusion as recorded in the charge-sheet.
