Issue notice to the respondents, returnable within four weeks.

Learned counsel for the appellant submits that in an identical writ petition filed by the company through another director, the Court passed order to decide the revision petition and also directed that the notice of recovery shall be not effected after five days of deciding the writ petition.

The revision petition was decided and the recovery orders were upheld, which were challenged by the company through another director before the Court within five days of passing of the order.

The Court vide order dated 27.03.2026 had issued notices, but no interim protection has been extended resulting into the properties of the Directors being attached.

Learned counsel submits that proceedings are being undertaken against one of the Directors, but it is the company, which was before the Court and, therefore, even if a new petition being filed through another Director, the relief ought to have been extended to the company itself and, therefore, to all the Directors.

We notice that the case has been listed for 23.04.2026 after issuing notices to the respondents by the learned Single Judge.

Taking into consideration the peculiar facts as pointed out, where the learned Single Judge had earlier protected the company from the recovery proceedings till adjudication of the revision petition and challenge to the order passed in the revision is before the learned Single Judge, we deem it appropriate to restrain the respondents from taking up recovery proceedings against the company including its Director till the disposal of the writ petition.

We, however, request the learned Single Judge to decide the writ petition expeditiously.
