Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that although four personal hearings were afforded to the petitioner, the same were scheduled at short and unreasonable intervals.

It is submitted that the said hearings were reduced to a mere empty formality. It is next submitted that the entire proceedings pertaining to the period of 2020-2024 were rushed and concluded with a mere gap of two to four days between consecutive dates. It is highlighted that the *bona fide* adjournment applications preferred by the petitioner were arbitrarily ignored and not even considered by the Employees State Insurance Corporation. It is further submitted that the said actions amount to a gross violation of the principles of natural justice.

Heard the preliminary submissions advanced by the learned counsel.

Issue notices to the respondents.

List the matter after three weeks.

In the meantime, taking note of the facts and circumstances of the case, it is directed that no coercive action shall be taken against the petitioner pursuant to the impugned proceedings.
