Issue notice to respondents.

Ms. Sunita Meena, Advocate, appearing for Mr. Bhunesh Sharma, learned AAG, puts in appearance on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 and Mr. Laxmikant Sharma, Advocate, appearing for Mr. Ram Naresh Vijay, Advocate, puts in appearance on behalf of respondent No.4.

Hence, service is complete. Notice need not be filed

Learned counsel for the respondents pray for and are granted ten days' time to file reply to the writ petition.

It is also noted that the present writ petition has been filed stating that the alleged complaint on the basis of which an amount of Rs.1,00,000/- has been put on hold in the bank account of the petitioner was paid to the petitioner on 25.03.2026 in pursuance to a business transaction.

In support of the same, Invoice No.13 dated 25.03.2026 (Annexure-4) has been annexed with the present petition, which reflects three transactions of Rs.51,000/-, Rs.1,00,000/- and Rs. 21,000/- being done by the complainant in favour of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that on the very next date, i.e. 26.03.2026, a complaint was filed by the said purchaser with the intent to blackmail the petitioner and to extort the abovementioned amounts as involved in the said business transaction.

Accordingly, let reply be specifically filed by the respondent – State with respect to said averments of the petitioner as well.

List the matter on 12.05.2026.
