1. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that on the basis of false allegations, FIR No.157/2024 has been registered against the petitioners at Police Station Laxmangarh (Alwar), District Alwar (Raj.) for the offences punishable under Sections 420, 406, 467, 468, 471 and 120B of IPC. It is submitted that marriage of petitioner No.1 was fixed with daughter of complainant-respondent No.2. He submits that complainant party is not interested in solemnizing this marriage, for the reasons best

known to them. It is submitted that to come out of this relationship, present FIR has been lodged alleging therein that employee ID of petitioner No.1 is fake and he does not hold a Government Job. It is submitted that false facts have been narrated in the FIR. A letter dated 06.04.2024, issued by Principal of Government Girls College, Dholpur is annexed with this petition as Annexure-3, which clearly indicates that petitioner no.1 is working on the post of Lab Assistant. It is further submitted that salary slip of petitioner No.1 is also annexed with this petition as Annexure-4, wherein, same employee ID has been mentioned.

2. In view of the above submissions, issue notice to the respondents.

3. Learned State Counsel accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1-State. Copy of this criminal misc. petition has already been supplied in his office.

4. Let notice be issued to respondent No.2, through both the process, returnable on the next date of hearing. Requisites be filed within a period of 10 days, failing which, this petition shall stand dismissed without any further reference to the Bench.

5. List this case on 26.07.2024. Till the next date of hearing, no coercive steps shall be taken against the petitioners in connection with FIR No.157/2024 registered at Police Station Laxmangarh (Alwar), District Alwar (Raj.).
