1. Instant anticipatory bail preferred by applicant-accused **Dinesh S/o Prabhudayal** under Section 482 of BNSS for grant of pre-arrest bail in FIR No.128/2026 dated 20.03.2026 registered at P.S. Bandikui, District Dausa for under Section 8/21 of NDPS Act.
2. Learned counsel for applicant submits that 5.42 grams of smack recovered from accused-Savitri, who was granted bail by a Coordinate Bench on 06.04.2026. He further submitted that on the basis of information given by Savitri, present applicant was arrayed as an accused. He further submitted that the information of co-accused is not admissible in evidence and present applicant having no connection with main accused Savitri. He further submitted that there is no evidence on record to incriminate the present applicant.
3. Aforesaid contentions were opposed by learned Public Prosecutor. He submitted report received from P.S. Baijupara, Dausa.

4. Heard learned counsel for the applicant and learned Public Prosecutor. Perused the material placed on record.

5. Recovery of 5.42 grams of smack was effected from Savitri and FIR No.128/2026 was registered by police. Savitri was granted bail by a Coordinate Bench on 06.04.2026. The allegation against present applicant is having active communication with Savitri. The present applicant is source of supply of narcotics to Savitri.

6. Considering the seriousness and gravity of allegations, no case is made out by grant of anticipatory bail particularly looking to the allegation relating to NDPS Act.

7. Accordingly, the application for bail filed under Section 482 of BNSS preferred by **Dinesh S/o Prabhudayal** is hereby dismissed.
