1. The present bail application under Section 483 of BNSS is filed by the applicant-accused **Rohit Gurjar S/o Shri Ramniwas Gurjar** seeking bail in respect of a criminal case registered as FIR No.109/2026 dated 20.03.2026 registered at P.S. Shahpura (Jaipur Rural), District - Jaipur Rural, for the offence under Section 8/20 of NDPS Act.
2. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that the applicant has been falsely implicated in the matter and the investigation against him is complete and he is no more required in investigation. He further submits that there are no chance of fleeing of applicant accused from the jurisdiction of this Hon'ble Court. He also submits that the applicant undertakes not to repeat offence and cooperate with investigation/trial, which will take time.

3. Learned counsel for applicant submits that no recovery was effected from the possession of present applicant and he was arrayed as an accused only on the information of co-accused Dhreeraj Kumar. He further submitted that there is no direct evidence to connect present applicant with any criminal activity. He further submitted that the applicant is just 18 year old person.
4. Learned Public Prosecutor has vehemently opposed the bail application and submitted that the allegations are grave and serious in nature.
5. Heard learned counsel for the applicant-accused and learned Public Prosecutor. Perused the material placed on record by both the parties.
6. On 20.03.2026, SHO, P.S. Shahpura, has intercepted a motorcycle No. RJ52-SG-9116 and recovered 2.033 kg of ganja from backpack in possession of Dhreeraj Kumar. Police has arrested Dheeraj Kumar and registered an FIR No.109/2026 at P.S. Shahpura, District Jaipur. On the basis of investigation, police has named present applicant as the source of ganja and arrested him on 08.04.2026 under Section 8/29 of NDPS Act. There is no criminal antecedents against the applicant.
7. Upon hearing the arguments and perusing the record, we have found that the applicant-accused is no more required in the investigation and he is in custody for quite some time. The further proceedings will take its own time, therefore, looking to entirety of facts and circumstances of the case and without expressing any opinion on merits of the case,

the Court deems it appropriate to grant bail to the applicant-accused.

8. Thus, the instant bail application filed on behalf of applicant-accused **Rohit Gurjar S/o Shri Ramniwas Gurjar**, is hereby allowed and the applicant-accused is ordered to be released on bail upon furnishing a personal bond of ₹50,000/- with two sureties of like amount to the satisfaction of the Trial Court with the following conditions:-

- (i) The applicant-accused shall not tamper with evidence or influence the witness in any manner.
- (ii) The applicant-accused shall not indulge in any criminal activity and shall not repeat any criminal offence punishable under the Law.
- (iii) The applicant-accused shall attend the hearing of the Trial Court on the date fixed by the Trial court or as and when asked to appear before the Trial Court.
- (iv) In case of any violation of above conditions, the bail granted to the applicant-accused shall be liable to be canceled.

9. The Registry is directed to send a copy of this order to the Trial Court through E-mail.
