1. Heard on the interim stay application.
2. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submits that the impugned termination orders have been passed on the ground that there was no sanction for continuation of the posts for which, the petitioners were recruited on contract basis. His submission is that the present impugned orders have only been passed so as to enable the employer to recruit fresh employees on contract basis.
3. Having considered the submissions advanced by the learned counsel for the petitioners, the respondents are directed to continue the services of the petitioners, if the scheme is extended and they are restrained from replacing the services of the petitioners with another set of employees.
4. Issue notice to the respondents, returnable within a period of four weeks.
5. List the matter on **04.07.2026**.
