Order

1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that, at the outset, he is withdrawing/not pressing the grounds of transfer as alleged in the application dated 10.04.2026; but alternatively submits that in the interest of justice and in order to maintain the faith of the people in the judiciary, the Appeal No. 14/2026 may kindly be transferred from the Court of learned Additional District Judge No.10, Jaipur Metropolitan-I, Sanganer, to any other court of competent jurisdiction. At the same time, he also submits that

he has no objection if the appeal as well as cross appeal is heard expeditiously on priority by the transferee court.

2. Per Contra, learned counsel for the respondents seriously disputes the allegations leveled against the Presiding Officer and the grounds of transfer as alleged in the present writ petition. However, to maintain the faith in the judiciary, which is the hallmark of this institution, and to ensure transparency, he has no objection if the matter is transferred to the learned District Judge, Jaipur Metropolitan-I, Jaipur, provided the main appeal as well as cross appeal are disposed of expeditiously, in a time bound manner.

3. Heard.

4. The Judiciary is not respected for its knowledge or wisdom only, but for the faith that people repose in it for impartiality or transparency.

5. Thus, while appreciating the gesture shown by both the lawyers as mentioned hereinabove, in view of the consensus arrived at between the parties and in order to maintain the faith people repose in the judiciary, which is the hallmark of this institution, this Court, without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with the following directions:-

- i. The Civil Regular Appeal No. 14/2026 titled as '*Ram Gopal Vs. Gaurishankar & Ors.*' stands transferred from the Court of learned Additional District Judge No.10, Jaipur Metropolitan-I, Sanganeer, to the learned District Judge, Jaipur Metropolitan-I, for disposal of the appeal as well as cross appeal.

ii. The learned Additional District Judge No.10, Jaipur Metropolitan-I, Sanganer, is directed to send the entire record of the case to the learned District Judge, Jaipur Metropolitan-I.

iii. Since this order has been passed on the basis of a consensus arrived at between the parties, the parties are hereby directed to provide necessary co-operation in the matter, and appear before the learned District Judge, Jaipur Metropolitan-I on 15.05.2026.

iv. The learned District Judge, Jaipur Metropolitan-I is directed to dispose of the aforesaid appeal as well as cross appeal within a period of one (1) month from the date of receipt of the record of the case.

6. Registrar (Judicial) is directed to send a copy of this order to the learned Additional District Judge No.10, Jaipur Metropolitan-I, Sanganer, forthwith, for necessary compliance.

7. Stay application(s) and all other pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
