1. Heard on the interim stay application.
2. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that the impugned termination order has been passed on the ground that there was no sanction for continuation of the posts for which, the petitioner was recruited on contract basis. His submission is

that the present impugned order has only been passed so as to enable the employer to recruit fresh employees on contract basis.

3. Having considered the submissions advanced by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the respondents are directed to continue the services of the petitioner, if the scheme is extended and they are restrained from replacing the services of the petitioner with another new set of employees.

4. Issue notice to the respondents, returnable within a period of four weeks.

5. List the matter on 22.05.2026.
