The present criminal miscellaneous petition has been filed by the petitioners challenging the FIR No.0172/2026 dated 07.04.2026 registered at Police Station Bhiwadi, District Bhiwadi, for the alleged offences punishable under Section 115(2), 324(4), 324(5), 352, 351(2), 351(3), 333 and 3(5) of BNS, 2023.

Mr. Ravindra Singh Shekhawat, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that for the offence alleged to have been committed by the petitioners on 07.04.2026, preventive action was taken by the police authorities and Complaint No.0124/2026 dated 07.04.2026 was registered, wherein the petitioners were arrested and subsequently, released on bail on 10.04.2026.

Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that the said complaint records that had the petitioners not been arrested, they would have committed an offence and considering the same, the petitioners were arrested.

Learned counsel for the petitioners also submits that surprisingly, for an offence alleged to have been committed at the very same location, the impugned FIR has been lodged which indicates that the contents of the impugned FIR are not only improbable but entirely concocted and the impugned FIR is nothing but an abuse of the process of law.

Taking note of the above, issue notice to the respondents.

Learned Public Prosecutor puts in appearance on behalf of respondent No.1.

Let notice be issued for respondent No.2, returnable within six weeks. Notice be also sent through registered post in addition to the normal process.

List the matter on 26.05.2026.
