1. Matter has come up on application (IA No.1/2025) for seeking permission to amend the writ petition.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of subsequent events that transpired during the pendency of the writ petition, the present amendment application is enunciated. He further submits that the petitioner may be permitted to incorporate Para Nos.3 to 24 as mentioned in the application, and to substitute the grounds under G, H, I, J & K, and to substitute/amend the prayer clause as mentioned in the application. He further submits that the aforesaid amendments are required to avoid multiplicity of litigation.
3. Learned counsel for the respondents without filing reply to the said application orally opposes the said submissions.
4. Heard.

5. Since the required amendments fall within the category of subsequent developments that have transpired during the pendency of the writ petition.

6. Thus, for the reasons mentioned in the application, this Court deems it appropriate to allow the application (IA No.1/2025) with a caveat that the respondents are at liberty to file their reply to the said amended pleas.

7. Accordingly, the application (IA No.1/2025) is allowed.

8. Learned counsel for the petitioners is directed to file the amended writ petition within fifteen (15) days from today with an advance copy to the learned counsels for the respondents.
