The present criminal writ petition has been filed by the petitioners seeking protection as they are residing together in a live-in relationship.

Petitioner No.1 is a divorcee and petitioner No.2 is a married person living separately from his wife for the last twelve years.

Learned Public Prosecutor, at the very outset, has brought attention of this Court to the judgment dated 29.01.2025 passed by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court in ***S.B. Criminal Writ Petition No.2183/24*** and other connected matters titled as ***Reena & Anr. Versus State of Rajasthan & Ors.***, wherein the following issue has been referred to a Special/Larger Bench :-

"Whether a married person living with an unmarried person, without dissolution of his/her marriage or/and whether two married persons with two different marriages living in live-in-relationship, without dissolution of their marriages, are entitled to get protection order from the Court?"

Taking note of the above, while the present criminal writ petition is kept pending, petitioners would be at liberty to file an appropriate application before respondent No.5 – Station House Officer, Police Station – Chomu, Jaipur Rural, who, after analyzing the facts and circumstances, more particularly, the threat perceptions, as alleged by the petitioners, would decide the said application.

Accordingly, list the matter after six weeks.
