The instant interim application has been preferred on behalf of the applicant-appellant under Section 430 of B.N.S.S. seeking interim suspension of sentence to the appellant, namely **Siyaram S/o Shri Shrimayaram**, on the ground of his cousin brother's marriage.

Submissions of learned counsel appearing for the appellant is that the marriage of the cousin's brother of appellant, namely Sugreev, is going to be solemnized on 25.04.2026 and he is the son of the appellant's uncle (Chacha). As per the enclosed marriage card, the marriage functions starts from 21.04.2026 onwards. The presence of the appellant is necessary to perform the social responsibilities during the marriage ceremony. Hence, it is prayed that the appellant may be granted interim bail

Learned Public Prosecutor for the State has verified the factum of the marriage of the cousin brother of the appellant.

Heard. Perused the material made available on record.

Taking into consideration the submissions made by learned counsel appearing for appellant and considering the fact that the marriage of the cousin brother of the appellant is going to be solemnized on 25.04.2026, but without expressing any opinion on the merits/demerits of the case, in the interest of justice, this Court deems it just and proper to enlarge the appellant on interim application for suspension of sentence, at this stage.

Accordingly, the present interim application for suspension of sentence is **allowed** and it is, hereby, directed that the Superintendent/concerned, District Jail, Dholpur shall release the appellant on interim bail for a period of seven days from the date of his actual release forthwith, upon furnishing his personal bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with two sureties of Rs.25,000/- each to the satisfaction of the Superintendent/concerned, District Jail, Dholpur with the stipulation that he shall surrender himself before the Superintendent/concerned, District Jail, Dholpur after completion a period of seven days at 05:00 P.M. He shall also maintain peace and tranquility during the period of interim bail. In case, he fail to surrender on the stipulated date, the jail authority shall proceed in accordance with law.
