1. The present bail application under Section 483 of BNSS is filed by the applicant-accused **Jal Singh Meena S/o Late Shri Girraj Prasad Meena** seeking bail in respect of a criminal case registered as FIR No.19/2026 dated 15.01.2026 registered at P.S. CPS Jaipur, District- ACB District, for the offence under Sections 7, 7A, 8 of Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 (Amended Act, 2018) and Section 61(2) of BNS, 2023.
2. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that the applicant has been falsely implicated in the matter and the investigation against him is complete and he is no more required in investigation. He further submits that there are no chance of fleeing of applicant accused from the jurisdiction of this Hon'ble Court. He also submits that the

applicant undertakes not to repeat offence and cooperate with investigation/trial, which will take time.

3. Learned counsel for applicant submits that only on ground of suspicion present applicant was arrayed as an accused and after his arrest, a charge-sheet is filed against him. He further submitted that neither there is any evidence about demand of bribery nor evidence of any pending work, but still present applicant was forwarded to face trial after his arrest.
4. Learned Public Prosecutor has vehemently opposed the bail application and submitted that the allegations are grave and serious in nature. Learned Public Prosecutor has submitted report received from the office of ACB, Jaipur.
5. Heard learned counsel for the applicant-accused and learned Public Prosecutor. Perused the material placed on record by both the parties.
6. On 15.01.2026, P.S. CPS, Jaipur, ACB District has registered an FIR under Sections 7, 7A, 8 of Prevention of Corruption Act (Amended Act) and Section 61(2) of BNS Act. During investigation, ACB has verified complaints received from different sources and role and involvement of several people were investigated. After investigation, it was found that Jal Singh Meena (present applicant), Nirmal Kumar @ Sanjay Yadav, Vikram Pratap Singh, Mahendra Prajapat, Sunil Prajapat, Krishna Singh Rathor, Budhhe Singh, Manohar Nayak, Pardeep Singh Jodha and Ramuram are involved in commission of crime, hence they were arrested as charges against them found proved but kept investigation pending

against Rishiraj Singh, Jagjeet Singh @ Jagat Singh @ Jagat Banna and Brijesh. Present applicant is in custody and charge-sheet has already been filed. No recovery has been effected from present applicant.

7. Upon hearing the arguments and perusing the record, we have found that the applicant-accused is no more required in the investigation and he is in custody for quite some time. The further proceedings will take its own time, therefore, looking to entirety of facts and circumstances of the case and without expressing any opinion on merits of the case, the Court deems it appropriate to grant bail to the applicant-accused.
8. Thus, the instant bail application filed on behalf of applicant-accused **Jal Singh Meena S/o Late Shri Girraj Prasad Meena**, is hereby allowed and the applicant-accused is ordered to be released on bail upon furnishing a personal bond of ₹50,000/- with two sureties of like amount to the satisfaction of the Trial Court with the following conditions:-
 - (i) The applicant-accused shall not tamper with evidence or influence the witness in any manner.
 - (ii) The applicant-accused shall not indulge in any criminal activity and shall not repeat any criminal offence punishable under the Law.
 - (iii) The applicant-accused shall attend the hearing of the Trial Court on the date fixed by the Trial court or as and when asked to appear before the Trial Court.

(iv) In case of any violation of above conditions, the bail granted to the applicant-accused shall be liable to be canceled.

9. The Registry is directed to send a copy of this order to the Trial Court through E-mail.
