Learned counsel for the petitioner has relied upon Annexure.1, order dated 29.01.2026 drawn from the office of respondent No.5. It is submitted that in the light of budget pronouncement, the State government in-line with the Central Government proposed for establishment and installation of ropeways at various religious and tourist places. It is further submitted that in view thereof, one of such locations was at Amber Fort, Nahargarh Fort and the Jaigarh Fort - Ropeway project.

Further, it is submitted that for the same, announcements and budget allocations were also made, as articulated in the finance bill, however, eager to attain the said tender, sans any advertisement, three parties approached and applied with the respondents; namely the petitioner, the respondent No.4 and one other company. It is submitted that in the prevailing circumstances, the provisions of the RTPP Act were not made applicable, albeit the said project falls under the ambit of

'procurement' as defined under Section 2 (13) of the RTPP Act 2012.

It is next submitted that the minutes of the meeting dated 02.09.2025 (Annexure.2), are self-explanatory qua the fact that the petitioner was working upon the establishment of the ropeway, with a primary input of approximately Rs. Eighty Crores, and a conscious mind that zilch or minimum disturbance to the forest land, flora and fauna. However, the cost as projected by the respondent No.4 i.e. one of the applicants qua the said project, was approximately Rs. Three-fifty Crores with grave exploitation of, and damage to the forest area, yet, adopting a biased, prejudiced and for the reasons best known, the respondents have granted preliminary approval vide Annexure.3, order dated 02.02.2026 to Respondent No.4.
