1. Learned Senior Counsel Mr. G.S. Bapna, appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that the factual matrix and the questions of law involved herein are entirely identical to those raised and pending before this Court in **S.B. Civil Writ Petition No. 7761/2026**, titled **Ultravibrant Integrated Energy Limited v. State of Rajasthan & Ors.**
2. It is submitted that an *ex-parte* interim protection has already been granted by this Court in the aforesaid connected matter.
3. Heard the preliminary submissions advanced by the learned counsel.
4. Issue notices to the respondents, returnable within three weeks.
5. In addition to the regular mode of service, '*dasti*' service is permitted.

6. Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to supply a copy of the present petition in the office of the learned Advocate General during the course of the day.
7. List the matter after three weeks, along with **S.B. Civil Writ Petition No. 7761/2026** after reflecting the name of Mr. Sheetanshu Sharma as counsel for the respondents in the cause list.
8. In the meantime, maintaining parity with the connected matter, the effect and operation of condition Nos. 3 and 5, as enshrined in the impugned letter dated 24.12.2025, along with any consequential actions arising therefrom, shall be kept in abeyance and shall not be made applicable to the petitioner.
9. It is directed that no coercive steps shall be taken against the petitioner till the next date of hearing.
