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**HON'BLE MR. JUSTICE PRAVEER BHATNAGAR**

**Order**

**04/05/2026**

1. The instant appeals have been filed under Section 14-A of SC/ST (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 on behalf of the appellants, who are in custody in connection with F.I.R. No.144/2026 dated 12.04.2026, registered at Police Station Bagru, District Jaipur (West) for the offences under Sections 189(2), 115(2), 126(2), 140(3) and 352 of BNS and Sections 3(1)(r), 3(1)(S) and 3(2)(va) of SC/ST (Prevention of Atrocities) Act against the order dated 20.04.2026 and 17.04.2026 passed by the learned Special Judge, SC/ST (Prevention of Atrocity) Cases, (Additional Sessions Judge No.02) Jaipur Metropolitan Second, whereby, these bail applications preferred under Section 483 of BNSS on behalf of the appellants were rejected.
2. Learned counsel for the appellants submits that the appellants have falsely been implicated in the case. Counsels for the accused-appellants further submit that the injuries sustained

to injured were found to be simple blunt in nature. There are no grievous or dangerous to life injuries to the injured. There are no criminal antecedents against the accused-appellants. It is further submitted that the trial/investigation of the case may take considerable time, therefore, the appeals of accused-appellants may be allowed.

3. Per contra, learned Public Prosecutor as well as learned counsel for the complainant have vehemently opposed the arguments advanced on behalf of the appellants. It is contended by learned counsel for the complainant that the accused-appellants along with the other co-accused after abusing caste based slurs assaulted Ramdhan Jatav, Ganesh, Darshan Singh, Lakhan, Sanjay and Mukesh Singh and all the injured sustained injuries and Ramdhan Jatav sustained 8 injuries, therefore, considering the aforesaid facts, the appeals of the accused-appellants may be dismissed.

4. Heard and perused the material available on record.

5. Considering the fact that the injuries sustained to injured Ramdhan Jatav, Ganesh, Darshan Singh, Lakhan, Sanjay and Mukesh Singh were found to be simple blunt in nature. There are no criminal antecedents against the accused-appellants. The investigation/trial of the case may take considerable time, therefore, considering the aforesaid facts, I deem it just and proper to allow the appeal.

6. Consequently, these instant appeals are allowed. The impugned order dated 20.04.2026 and 17.04.2026 passed by the learned Special Judge, SC/ST (Prevention of Atrocity) Cases, (Additional Sessions Judge No.02) Jaipur Metropolitan Second, are

hereby set aside. It is ordered that the accused-appellants namely: **1. Ranveer Singh Son Of Shri Amar Singh, 2. Lucky Yadav, S/o-Shri Chouthmal Yadav, 3. Ramsahai Yadav and 4. Deepak Kumawat**, who are in custody in connection with F.I.R. No.144/2026 dated 12.04.2026, registered at Police Station Bagru, District Jaipur (West) shall be released on bail; provided they furnish a personal bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- and two surety bonds of Rs.25,000/- each to the satisfaction of the learned trial court with the stipulation to appear before that Court on all dates of hearing and as and when called upon to do so.
