1. Petitioner has come up with a case that he rendered regular services on the post of GNM as a Covid Health Assistant at Chief Medical and Health Officer, Dausa, from May, 2023 onward and his services have been appreciated by the concerned Medical Officer vide Certificate dated 09.04.2026, but on the same date, in place of petitioner, another person namely Shushil Kumar Gurjar, on contract basis has been appointed as GNM in place of petitioner showing that petitioner has tendered his resignation.
2. Petitioner, in Para No.6 of the writ petition, has categorically pleaded that he never tendered any resignation nor expressed any intention to resign from work, yet in order to replace the petitioner from another contractual employee, his contractual engagement has been dispensed with vide order dated 09.04.2026, recording a false and incorrect fact of his resignation.
3. In such backdrop of factual matrix, copy of the writ petition was provided in the office of Additional Government Counsel on

05.05.2026 with direction to complete his instructions from the respondents about the entire facts, but counsel for respondents failed to get update his instructions. Such practice of Additional Government Counsel is deprecated and he is expected to come next time with update instructions, more particularly, when the Court has issued specific directions. The concerned Officer In-charge/ Officer be also held liable for not updating the Additional Government counsel.

4. Heard.

5. Issue notice to respondents of writ petition as also of stay application.

6. Considering the peculiar facts and circumstances, operation of impugned order dated 09.04.2026 whereunder the petitioner has been replaced by respondent No.7 on the post of GNM at Janta Clinic, Kothiwali Dhani Mandawari, Block Lalsot, District Dausa, shall remain stayed and respondents are directed to allow the petitioner to continue on the post, on the same remuneration, on which he was engaged in the year 2023.

7. A copy of this order be sent to the Principal Secretary, Department of Law & Legal Affairs, Government of Rajasthan for necessary action.
