1. These instant bail applications have been filed under Section 483 BNSS on behalf of accused-petitioners. The accused-petitioners have been arrested in connection with FIR No. 190/2024 registered at Police Station Chitrakoot District Jaipur (west) for the offences under Section 3/25 of Arms Act.
2. Learned counsel for the accused-petitioners submits that the accused-petitioners have falsely been implicated in this case. It is

contended that main accused Sumit Yadav has been enlarged on bail by Hon'ble Apex Court in SLP (criminal) No. 2920/2026 vide order dated 12.03.2026 and other similarly placed co-accused Ramswaroop Jat and Jeet Ram Chaudhary have also been enlarged on bail by Hon'ble Apex Court on the ground of long incarceration. It is also contended that coordinate Bench of this court also enlarged co-accused Shahid Khan on bail vide order dated 13.04.2026 on the ground of parity as the other accused have been enlarged on bail by Hon'ble Supreme Court. It is also contended that out of 31 cited witnesses only 15 witnesses have been examined till now. The accused-petitioners are in custody since 26.04.2024 and 27.06.2024 respectively and the trial of the case may take considerable time, therefore, the bail applications of the accused-petitioners may be allowed.

3. Learned Public Prosecutor has vehemently opposed these bail applications.

4. Heard and perused the material available on record.

5. Considering the fact that Hon'ble Supreme court and coordinate Bench of this court have already enlarged the co-accused persons on bail and the case of the present petitioners are not distinguishable from the other co-accused, therefore without commenting anything on the merits of the case, I deem it just and proper to enlarge the accused-petitioners on bail.

6. Accordingly, the bail applications under Section 483 BNSS are allowed and it is ordered that the accused-petitioners 1. Manoj Singh @ Priyanshu Choudhary S/o Shri Maharaj Singh, 2. Mukesh Choudhary Alais Mukesh Haritwal S/o Shri Thanaram, in connection with FIR No. 190/2024 registered at Police Station

Chitrakoot District Jaipur (west) shall be enlarged on bail provided they furnish personal bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with two sureties of Rs.25,000/- each to the satisfaction of the learned trial Judge for their appearance before the court concerned on all the dates of hearing and as and when called upon to do so. The concerned trial Judge shall verify the address and contact details of the sureties through concerned SHO before releasing the accused-petitioners on bail.

7. The accused Mukesh Choudhary Alais Mukesh Haritwal S/o Shri Thanaram, is also directed to mark his presence on 25th of every month till conclusion of trial before the concerned police station. The SHO of the concerned police station shall send the presence report of the accused petitioner on the same day to the trial court every month. In case of any breach to the above condition, the learned Public Prosecutor shall be free to move the application against the petitioner for cancellation of the bail before the concerned Court.

8. The accused-petitioner is also directed to submit his present address along with the mobile number to the concerned SHO within seven days of release and the concerned SHO shall verify the said address and the mobile number. In case if the petitioner changes his address or mobile number, he shall submit the same before the concerned SHO so also before the concerned learned trial court.

9. A copy of this order shall be sent to the concerned SHO for its strict compliance.
