1. The instant bail application has been filed on behalf of the accused-petitioners under Section 483 of BNSS in connection with FIR No. 38/2026 registered at Police Station Indergarh, District Bundi for the offence(s) punishable under Sections 115(2), 126(2), 110 & 3(5) of B.N.S., 2023.
2. Learned counsel for the accused-petitioners submits that the accused-petitioners have been falsely implicated in this case. He also submits that the accused-petitioners are in custody since long. He further submits that recovery has already been effected and the accused-petitioners are not required for further

investigation. He further submits that it is a matter of cross FIR, which is registered with Police Station Indergarh bearing FIR No. 39/2026 for the offences punishable under Sections 115(2), 126(2), 110 & 189(2) of B.N.S., 2023.; conclusion of trial will take its own time, so no fruitful purpose would be served by keeping the accused-petitioners behind the bars and, therefore, prays that the accused-petitioners may be granted the benefit of bail under Section 483 of BNSS.

3. *Per contra*, learned Public Prosecutor vehemently opposes the submissions made by learned counsel for the accused-petitioners hereinabove. It is further submitted that there are one-one other criminal cases registered against the accused-petitioners, Suresh Kumar S/o Jansi Lal & Yuvraj S/o Suresh Kumar.

4. Having regard to the totality of the facts and circumstances of the case and considering the arguments advanced by learned counsel for both the parties; that the accused-petitioners are in custody since long and looking at the fact that the injuries sustained by the injured are neither fatal nor dangerous to life; that the accused-petitioners are not required for further investigation and it is a matter of cross FIR; trial will take its own time. Hence, this Court without expressing any opinion on the merits/demerits of the case, deems it just and proper to enlarge the accused-petitioners on bail.

5. Therefore, the instant bail application under Section 483 BNSS is accordingly, **allowed** and the accused-petitioners **Suresh Kumar S/o Jansi Lal, Dilkush S/o Suresh Kumar & Yuvraj S/o Suresh Kumar** are ordered to be released on bail, provided

each of them furnishes a personal bond in the sum of Rs. 1,00,000/- with two sureties of Rs. 50,000/- each to the satisfaction of the Trial Court, with the stipulation that they shall appear before that Court and any Court to which the matter is transferred, on all subsequent dates of hearing and as and when called upon to do so.

6. It is made clear that the accused-petitioners shall not involve in any offence(s) during currency of the bail.

7. It is made clear that in case the accused-petitioners get themselves involved in committing any kind of offences and in case any FIR is registered against them, in future, then in such eventuality the learned Public Prosecutor would be at liberty to file an application for cancellation of their bail.

8. The observation made hereinabove is only for decision of the instant bail application and would not have any impact on the trial of the case in any manner.
