1. Learned Advocate General appearing for JVVNL has informed that so far as the respondent is concerned, he has already been promoted after conclusion of the result of the inquiries, by opening the sealed cover. The respondent has accepted the promotion and

has joined on the promoted post. Learned Advocate General also points out that vide impugned order, apart from the directions issued for filing of affidavit, the Court had also restrained the appellant from conducting the further DPC for future year of 2026-27, whereas petitioner has already been promoted against the vacancies for the year 2024-25, in that view, he prays for vacating the stay order passed by the learned Single Judge.

2. Considering the peculiar circumstances of the case, the present appeal has been filed challenging the orders dated 09.04.2026, 20.04.2026 & 23.04.2026, whereby the learned Single Judge directed the Anti Corruption Bureau, Jaipur, Rajasthan to register a case against the CMD/MD Jaipur DISCOM, holding that the affidavit was misleading and the JVVNL asserted that the affidavit was correct, we, apart from staying the proceedings before the learned Single Judge, also direct that S.B. Civil Writ Petition No. 20478/2023 be tagged along with the present appeal and be heard together.

3. In the new circumstances, which have been brought before us, we hold that as on today, the main grievance relating to non-promotion of the writ petitioner stands duly satisfied. As regards the ascertain of the learned counsel for the petitioner that the roster register has not been properly maintained, the issue requires to be examined.

4. Admit.

5. The writ petition as well as the appeal shall now be heard in due course. The interim order passed by the learned Single Judge for not conducting the DPC stands vacated.

6. Put up in due course.



7. Interim orders dated 09.04.2026, 20.04.2026 & 23.04.2026 passed by the learned Single Judge shall remain stayed and the DPC shall be allowed to be conducted.
