1. The present writ petition has been preferred by the petitioner assailing the impugned order dated 12.02.2026 passed by the learned Additional Civil Judge No.17, Jaipur Metropolitan-I, Jaipur Headquarter Sanganer in Civil Suit No. 183/2023, titled as '*Sushil Kumar Jain Vs. Santosh Devi & Ors.*', whereby the petitioner's application under Section 151 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 (CPC), seeking consolidation and joint adjudication of other Civil Suits Nos. 183/2023, 194/2023 and 300/2023, has been dismissed.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that all the three suits pertain to the same property and both the subsequent suits are offspring of the first suit, therefore, in order to prevent conflict of judgments and to save time of the Court, the application under Section 151 of CPC was filed. However, the learned Court below erroneously and in a perverse manner dismissed the application.

He therefore prays that the impugned order dated 12.02.2026, being perverse, may kindly be quashed and set aside.

3. Heard.

4. In view of the submissions made hereinabove, issue notice to the respondents, returnable within six weeks.

5. Requisite PF and notices may be filed in two sets within a period of one week. Upon filing the same, one set be sent by ordinary post and another by registered post.

6. List the matter after six weeks.
