within a period of 7 days in light of **Pawan Meena vs. State of  
Rajasthan & Ors. (SBCWP No. 1665/2024)** and Circular  
issued by the Chief Secretary for the State of Rajasthan, dated  
19.02.2024.

3. This Court directs Respondent No.2/competent authority to  
consider the representation of the petitioner, if filed, and decide

the same within a period of 30 days, strictly in accordance with law, expeditiously as per the ratio encapsulated in **Pawan Meena (Supra)** and Circular dated 19.02.2024 (No. प. 10(1) प्रसु./अनु. -1/2012).
