1. These petitions are pending since 2018. The basic issue involved is that despite the implementation of *The Street Vendors (Protection of Livelihood and Regulation of Street Vending) Act, 2014* (for short 'Vendors Act'), the needful steps have not been taken by the respondents.
2. It is also contended that in spite of issuance of vendor's card, no allotment was made in the notified vending zones, rather there is no notification of the vending or non-vending zones.
3. Learned counsels for the respondents submit that due to the division of Jaipur Nagar Nigam in two parts i.e. Nagar Nigam (Heritage) and Nagar Nigam (Greater), the zones identified as non-vending zones and vending zones were not implemented.
4. Let the Commissioner of Nagar Nigam (Heritage) and Commissioner of Nagar Nigam (Greater) file an affidavit with regard to the effective steps taken in implementation of Vendors Act and for removal of unauthorized vending in Jaipur. In case of failure to do so, let both the Commissioners shall remain present in the Court.
