1. Learned Senior Counsel appearing for the appellant submits that appellant had sought withdrawal of the writ petition by moving an appropriate application stating that they had reconsidered and were not desirous to pursue the writ petition filed by them challenging the notices issued to them by respondent No.2-Urban Improvement Trust (UIT), Sawai Madhopur as well as respondent No.3-Tehsildar, Sawai Madhopur.
2. Learned Senior Counsel further submits that they want to pursue their case before the concerned authority and had mentioned the same in their application for withdrawal. However, learned Single Judge has directed the appellant to implead the Union of India, National Wildlife Board (through competent authority) and Home Affairs Department, Government of

Rajasthan as parties in the array of respondents and also directed the respondent No.5 and Officer in-Charge to remain present in the Court and also directed to seal the property of the appellant and to be taken in legal custody.

3. Learned Senior Counsel also submits that no reply was filed by any of the respondents and on oral statement made through video conferencing by respondent No.5, the aforesaid directions have been issued without there being any factual aspect.

4. Issue notice to respondents.

5. Ms. Pooja Sharma, learned counsel, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1-UDH Department.

6. Office is directed to issue notice to remaining respondents.

7. List this case on 07.05.2026.

8. Meanwhile and till further orders, the effect and operation of the order dated 15.04.2026 as well as proceedings pending before the learned Single Judge shall remain stayed.

9. Copy of the petition be also served on Mr. Manoj Sharma, learned Additional Advocate General, who appears for the UDH Department.
