1. Petitioner has filed this writ petition with the following prayers:-

"It is, therefore humbly prayed that Your Lordship may be kindly pleased to accept and allow the writ petition of the humble petitioner and by an appropriate writ, order or direction:-

a) By an appropriate writ, order or direction, the respondents may kindly be directed to regularize the services of the petitioner on their respective post after screening and consequently, give all the



benefits of the services from the date of their respective initial date of appointment in view of the provisions of Rajasthan Contractual Hiring to Civil Posts Rules, 2022.

b) By an appropriate writ, order or direction, the respondents may kindly be directed to treat the petitioners at par to the other employees who have been extended the benefits under the Rules of 2022."

c) By an appropriate writ, order or direction the petitioner may be directed to file representation before Chief Medical and Health Officer for regularization of service & for all the benefits of the services from the date of their respective initial date of appointment in view of the provisions of Rajasthan Contractual Hiring to Civil Posts Rules, 2022."

2. At the threshold, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner will be fully satisfied in case, he is granted liberty to submit a representation before the competent authority for redressing his grievances with regard to pay fixation.

3. In view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner, at the outset, this Court deems it just and proper to dispose of this writ petition by granting liberty to the petitioner to submit a representation before the competent authority, who shall consider and decide the same by a speaking order within a period of 60 days from the date of receipt of representation along with a certified copy of this order.

4. It is made clear that this Court has not expressed any opinion on merits of the case.

5. Pending application(s), if any, also stand(s) disposed of.
