Order

1. Defect(s) as pointed out by the Registry is waived.
2. On the urgency expressed by learned counsel for the petitioners, the matter is taken up for consideration of interim relief.
3. The present writ petition has been filed by the petitioners seeking issuance of *pattas* in their favour in respect of a portion of land bearing Khasra No.316/305 situated at Village Dantli, Tehsil Andhi, District Jaipur.
4. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are in possession of the said portion of land since long and have even applied for issuance of *patta* with the concerned

Gram Panchayat, in support of which, the receipt issued by Gram Panchayat, Bhawani, has been annexed along with the writ petition.

5. Learned counsel further submits that even the Sarpanch of Gram Panchayat, Bhawani, has recommended issuance of *patta* in favour of the petitioners, however, till date, no action has been taken and on the contrary, an order dated 24.04.2016 (Annexure-9) has been issued by the respondents to dispossess the petitioners from the said land.

6. Learned counsel submits that till the time, the petitioners' application for issuance of *patta* is not decided, no action could have been taken against the petitioners and in case, their possession is not safeguarded, irreparable loss would be caused to the petitioners.

7. Learned counsel also submits that the land being Khasra No.316/305 is recorded as a 'Gair Mumkin Abadi' land as is evident from Jamabandi for Samvat 2075-2078 (Annexure-2).

8. Taking note of the above, issue notices to respondents No.1 to 9.

9. Ms. Praveshika Singh, learned counsel appearing on behalf of Mr. V.D. Gathala, learned Assistant Government Counsel, accepts notices on behalf of respondents No.1 to 5.

10. Hence, service *qua* respondents No.1 to 5 stands complete. Notices be filed only for respondents No.6 to 9. Notices may also be sent through registered post in addition to normal process. Notices also be given *dasti* to learned counsel for the petitioners.

11. Learned counsel for the petitioners is directed to serve a copy of petition in the Offices of Mr. V.D. Gathala, learned

Assistant Government Counsel, who appears on behalf of respondents No.1 to 5, Mr. Kapil Prakash Mathur, learned Additional Advocate General, who appears on behalf of respondents No.6 to 8 and Mr. Bhunesh Sharma, learned Additional Advocate General, who appears on behalf of respondent No.9.

12. List the matter on 13.05.2026 after showing the names of Mr. V.D. Gathala, learned AGC, Mr. Kapil Prakash Mathur, learned AAG and Mr. Bhunesh Sharma, learned AAG, in the cause list.

13. Till the next date, the respondents are directed to not to dispossess the petitioners to the extent of their possession on Khasra No.316/305 situated at Village Dantli, Tehsil Andhi, District Jaipur.

14. However, respondents would be at liberty to file an application seeking vacation/modification of this order, if so advised.
